### OUR GOAL

Our mission is to offer amateur players a true professional-level competition and to encourage them to travel and connect with players from across Europe. You don't have to be a pro to travel for disc golf!

### Scoring

Each player's score must be confirmed and signed on the official PDGA scorecard. At least one player per group must record scores in Discgolf Metrix, while the others enter scores in PDGA Live Scoring. All players are required to keep a scorecard. If a player cannot keep an electronic score, the organizer will provide a paper scorecard.

### Membership and Conduct

A valid PDGA membership is required to participate. All PDGA rules regarding attire, alcohol consumption, and the no-smoking policy apply throughout the event.

### DIVISIONS

Men's: MA1, MA2, MA3, MA4

Women's: FA1, FA2, FA3, FA4

- A minimum of 50% of participation fees contributes to the prize fund.
- Prizes are items only; there are no cash payouts (0% monetary prize pool).
- In the case of a tie during the final round, sudden-death rules and start times will be announced no later than Saturday evening.

- Maximum field: 164 players. The organizer has the right to increase the number
- Each division is allocated 8 reserved spots during the first two registration stages.
- Every participant receives a Player's Package.

## REGISTRATION

Registration is conducted through Discgolf Metrix in three stages based on PDGA ratings.

### Stage 1 (approx. 2 weeks)

MA1 – Rating  $\geq 955$  or PRO status <970

MA2 – Rating 915–934

MA3 – Rating 870–899

MA4 – Rating 825–849

FA1 – All / PRO status <875

FA2 – Rating <825

FA3 – Rating <775

FA4 – Rating <725

## Stage 2 (approx. 3 weeks)

MA1 – Rating  $\geq 935$  or PRO status <970

MA2 – Rating 900–934

MA3 – Rating 850–899

MA4 – Rating 800–849

FA1 – All / PRO status <875

FA2, FA3, FA4 – Open only if players registered in Stage 1

## Stage 3 / 4 (both approx. 3 weeks)

MA1 – Amateur all / PRO status <970

MA2 – Rating <935

MA3 – Rating <900

MA4 – Rating <850

FA1 – All / PRO status <875

FA2, FA3, FA4 – Open only if players registered in Stage 1

**Note:** The entry fee for each registered player (not on a waiting list) must be received by the end of their registration stage. Players who fail to pay on time will be removed from the list.

The organizer reserves 10 wildcard spots, which will be announced after the final registration stage closes.

MA1 / FA1 - tour winners will receive Team Innova contracts

MA2 / FA2 - tour winners will receive Team Innova AMBASSADOR contracts

MA3 / FA3 - tour winners will have a chance to launch their own signature disc!

MA4 / FA4 - tour winners will have a chance to launch their own signature disc!

### Points system

1st 100p; 2nd 85p; 3rd 75p; 4th 70p; 5th 68p; 6th 66p

All other places - 2p from the place above until 0p. For first place in case of tie, final points will be calculated after sudden death. From second place player earns higher places points. You only earn points in the division you are competing in. **Points do not transfer to another division** if you change divisions during the tour.

For final result - points from **4 best tournaments** count.

The player who has most points at the end of the last tournament will win the tour.

In the case of a tie, the player with the highest place in any tournament will win.



For example, If player A has on 3rd, 6th, 6th, and 8th place, while player B has 5th, 7th, 7th, 7th respectively. Player A wins, since he/she finishes 3rd.

You can participate according to PDGA rules and limitations. If your PDGA rating is in MA1 division over 969 or FA1 over 874 and you are PRO-class player, you can not participate. This is the maximum limit for MA1 and FA1 divisions for PRO status. If you are AM status in PDGA, then there is no maximum limit.
