If place 72 is tied, the place in the MPO pool is determined by the lowest PDGA number. The Lowest PDGA number will play in the MPO pool, the remaining MPO players will play in the MIX pool.

Groups for Saturday are published on PDGA.

A-final

12 FPO players and 72 MPO player (plus shared places) will play the A-final. See www.pdga.com/tour/event/34716 for tee times in the A-final.

The A-final will be played with tee times on the white course. The FPO groups will tee off first (around 8^{00}) to allow filming both finals (we only have one film crew).

B-final

The players that does not qualify for the A-final will play the yellow course. It's not possible for a player to advance further than the first place in this pool.

PDGA does not yet support B-finales yet so the B-final will be listed as a separate event on PDGA: <u>www.pdga.com/tour/event/36675</u>

The goal is that all groups will consist of three players but depending on the number of players there might be one or two groups with four players. Maximum 54 players will play in the B-final.



Ground Under Repair


If areas are marked with blue sticks this indicated *ground under repair*. If your disc lands in this area, mark and throw your following throw (without penalty) from the nearest point outside the area, even if this marked point is closer to the basket.












OB is marked with tree logs, OB-sticks and 243 ft, -23 ft waterline. Only use DZ if disc never passes safe area.







OB is marked with water line, OB-sticks, **450 ft, +33 ft** tree logs and a stone fence. Use DZ if tee-shot is OB.

The temporary water is marked with sticks.**394 ft, -10 ft**If you land in it, you may use the DZ without penalty.


