Flights

- Round we will have random flights and mixed divisions feature card will be filmed by Dreamflight
- Round will be sorted by scores and mixed divisions lead card will be filmed by Dreamflight
- 3. Round will be within divisions MPO lead card will be filmed

Tee Times

On <u>Friday and Saturday</u> the first flight starts at 9:00. Every 15 minutes will be the next flight. There will be 2 ghost flights.

On <u>Sunday</u>, we have a **modified shotgun** start to make sure, you will get home earlier:

- All flight except 3 leading flights will start at 9:00 on different holes.
 (1-max. 15)
- 3 leading flights will have starting times at 9:10, 9:20, 9:30
- Tee times may be shifted on Friday and Saturday in case of bad weather forecast.

Ties

In the event of a tie for the first 1 places, holes 1, 2, 3 & 18 will be played in a loop until there is a decision.

Bad weather scenario



- In the event of a thunderstorm, we will interrupt the round with a loud signal & PDGA Scoring App. The teams must mark the current lie and immediately seek shelter or return to the TC.
- In the event of heavy rain, rounds may also be interrupted or shortened. This will be decided by the tournament management.
- Should other bad weather scenarios occur, this will be communicated during the round via a loud signal & PDGA Scoring App. The current lie must also be marked and all teams must immediately go to safety / the TC.

We will score with PDGA Live! (pdga.com/score)

ALL players must score. Each player is responsible for their own score. We will prepare scorecard for pickup at the TC if somebody needs them.

Important:

If there are any discrepancies, this must be discussed with the TD immediately after the last hole. If the team does not clear up the mistake immediately after the end of the round (10 minutes), this player receive +2 penalty throws on the total score. (PDGA 808)





General information


- We recommend that you do not use carts as the course is in very wooded terrain. Good footwear is also recommended, especially in wet conditions.
- OB is marked with orange flags. The lines are extended indefinitely if necessary (additional last green flag)
- Mandos are marked at the tee sign. Mando lines are marked with orange flags. DZ are marked with orange & white flags
- Relief Area (806.04) is marked with white flags.
- Hazard marking is blue
- Some tee areas are extended to the left or right so you are allow to throw on gras surface. This is marked with orange flags at the tee. If no flags are at the tee, the artificial grass is the tee-off area
- Banners, barriers, beach flags etc. are part of the course layout and may not be moved
- Nettles may be removed in accordance with PDGA rules
- Smoking during the round is not allowed
- Ant hills are played as relief areas (806.04)
- Puddles/water accumulations are played as casual areas/casual water (806.03)
- Baskets from the other layout count as casual areas 1m area around the circle (806.03)

For safety reasons, players may keep a safe distance of up to 2 meters from barbed wire or electric fences

- The 2-meter rule is not active


